

Butterfly

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished
(12" x 12" finished)

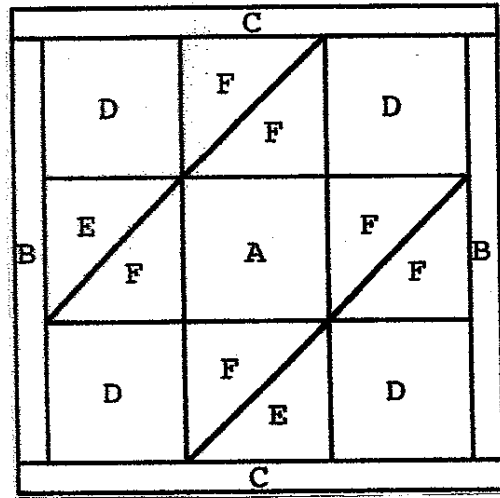
Background - white

D - 4" square
cut 4

E - 4 3/8" square
cut later

B - 1 1/4" x 11" rectangle
cut 2

C - 1 1/4" x 12 1/2" rectangle
cut 2



Wings - your choice (any combination up to three fabrics)

F - 4 3/8" square
cut 3

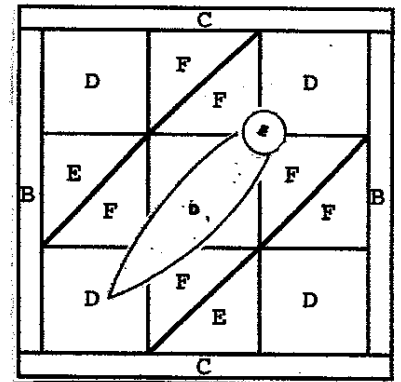
Body - again your choice

A - 4" square

Optional additional butterfly body

template D - 6" x 2" scrap

template E - 1 1/2" square scrap



Butterfly wings; pair up two of wings F and the last wings F with background E. Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of lighter fabric for each pair. Sew a scant 1/4" from each side of drawn line; cut apart on line. Each block will measure 4" square.

Lay out pieces. Starting at the top sew background D to two color wings to background D.

Middle row - sew wing/background to body A to tow color wings.

Bottom row - sew background D to wing/background to background D.

Sew rows together; block should measure 11" square. If it does cut background B & C as directed. If your block *does not* measure 11" x 11", adjust background B & C. Sew on background B & C.

You can now be done OR you can add the optional butterfly body. Using template D & E cut out butterfly body and head. Using your favorite appliqué add to your butterfly block.

Flutter, flutter, flutter.
