

Daffodil

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished
(12" x 12" finished)

Background - white

C - 6 1/8" x 5 1/8" rectangle

D - 6 1/8" x 5 1/8" rectangle

F - 3" x 3 1/2" rectangle
cut 2

G - 3" square

K - 6 3/8" square

cut later

A - 1" x 11 1/2" rectangle
cut 2

B - 1" x 12 1/2" rectangle
cut 2

Flower - your choice

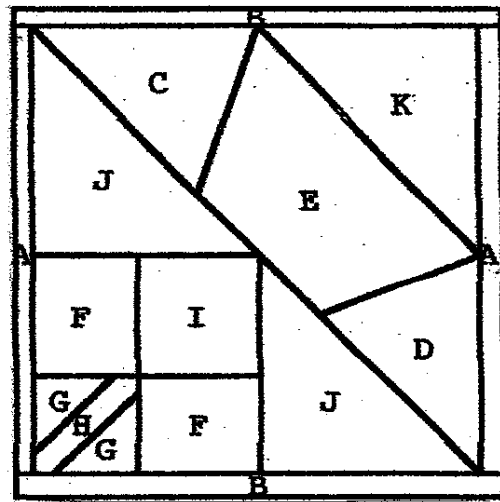
E - 8 5/8" x 4 3/8" rectangle

I - 3 1/2" square

J - 6 3/8" square

Stem - green

H - 5 1/4" x 1" rectangle

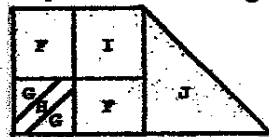


Starting at the bottom - cut background G diagonally into two triangles. Fold stem H in half, mark. (Stem H is long, we'll deal with it in a moment.) Center a background G triangle onto one side of stem H (I fold background G triangle in half to find the center), sew and repeat with other background G triangle on other side of stem H. Square up G-H-G to a 3" square

Add a background F to G-H-G stem piece. Add the other background F to flower I *watch placement*. Join these two pieces. Cut flower J in diagonally into two triangles.

Add on flower J triangle along the F-I side.

Add the other flower J triangle to other side.



Flower - on flower E measure 2" from lower left corner inward, mark. Place ruler from upper left corner to the mark on the edge near lower left corner; cut.

Measure 2" from lower right corner inward, mark. Place ruler from upper right corner to the mark on the edge near lower right corner; cut.



Cut background C & D from template B. Add to flower E. Cut background K diagonally in half; add background K to the top of unit C-E-C.

You have two large triangles time to sew them together. At this point your flower should measure 11 1/2" square. If not, adjust background A & B. Sew background A & B onto square to complete your daffodil.
