

## Rose

12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished  
(12" x 12" finished)

### Background - white

A - 1" x 12 1/2" rectangle  
cut 2

B - 1" x 11 1/2" rectangle  
cut 2

cut A & B later

F - 2 3/8" square  
cut 2

H - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle  
cut 2

I - 4" square  
cut 2

### Petals - four hues of color

J - darkest 3" x 8" rectangle

K - darkest 3" x 5 1/2" rectangle

L - med 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangle

M - med 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

N - med light 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

O - med light 2" square

P - lightest 2" square

### Leaves - you can choose

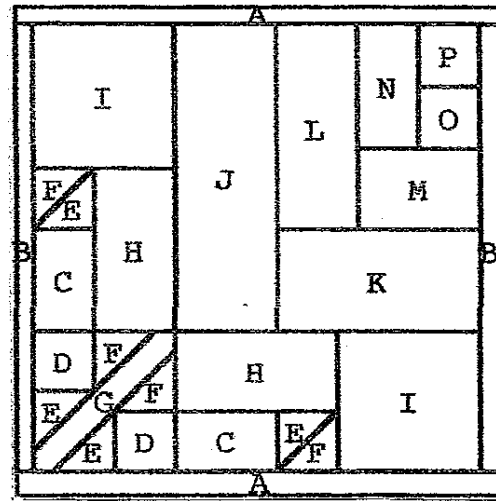
C - 2" x 3" rectangle  
cut 2

D - 2" square  
cut 2

E - 2 3/8" square  
cut 2

### Stem - your choice

G - 1" x 6" rectangle



The flower is sewn log cabin style.

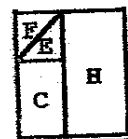
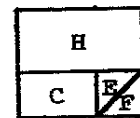
Sew petal P to petal O; add petal N. Sew on petal M; watch placement, it should match up with O-N. Add petal L (on the N-M side), petal K (L-M side) and finally the last, and largest, petal, petal J. Set aside.

Stem/leaf - Draw a line diagonally on the wrong side of only one background F. Sew leaf E to background F using a scant 1/4" from the drawn line on both sides.

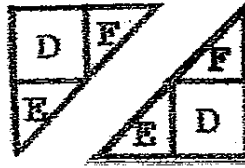
Cut apart on drawn line, press open; should measure 2" square.

Sew a leaf C to each E-F piece. Add background H, watch placement.

Make 2 ( they will be mirror image)



Cut one background **F** diagonally into two triangles. Cut one leaf **E** diagonally into two triangles. Sew leaf **D** to leaf **E**. Add background **F**. Make two (they will be mirror image).



Fold stem **G** in half and mark (stem **G** is long - don't worry we'll fix it soon), center and sew one **F-D-E** piece on each side of stem **G**. Square up to 4". Set aside.

Put together the block - Sew background **I** to leaf block **C-E-F-H**, make two. Sew one to flower block. Sew the other to the stem/leaf block, now sew these two pieces together.

At this point you block should measure 11 1/2" square. If not, adjust background **A** & **B** before you cut them (remember to increase length of background **A** if you widen background **B**); add to block.

And you're done!!
